


- Installing your WEATHER GUARD® Bulkhead for the Ram Promaster City is very clear cut following these instructions.
- This installation will not require cutting or drilling any sheet metal on the vehicle.

#### **TOOLS REQUIRED**

- 1/4" Ratchet Driver
- 3/8" Ratchet Driver
- 7/16" Socket
- 7/16" Wrench
- 13mm Wrench
- 10mm Socket (1/4" Drive)
- 13mm Socket (3/8" Drive)

#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

NOTE: BULKHEAD BASE will lean slightly toward rear of the van.

**STEP 1:** Locate fourteen attachment points on the vehicle. There are eight M8 weldnuts on the floor, two M6 weldnuts on each side of the B-pillars, and two M6 weldnuts on the roof panel reinforcement (FIGURE 1).

NOTE: You may need to loosen the B-pillar trims to access the M6 weldnuts.

**STEP 2:** Instal the header panel using the M6-1.0 x 16mm bolts. Do not tighten the bolts at this time (FIGURE 2).

**STEP 3:** Loosely install the M6 bolts on B-pillars enough to be able to slip on the bracket. Turn the bracket towards the inside of the vehicle. Use 1/4" drive rachet through the hole to snug up the bolts (FIGURE 3).

NOTE: The brackets are designed to tuck under the Bi-pillar trim panels on vehicles without the factory bulkhead.

**STEP 4:** Install the base panel using eight M8-1.25 x 25mm bolts. Use a 13mm wrench to avoid damaging the finish.

**STEP 5:** Install the upper panel using the supplied bolt kit. Use 7/16" ratchet/wrench.




FIGURE 4. DETAILED VIEW

NOTE: Mesh panel (96112-3-01) installs on the cabin side of the header panel and the brackets. Window panel (96512-3-01) installs on the cargo side of the header panel and the brackets (FIGURE 4).

STEP 6: Tighten all of the bolts.

This warranty terminates if the original purchaser transfers the WEATHER GUARD® Product to any other person.

What is Covered

All WEATHER GUARD® Products identified above that are purchased on or after January 1, 2009.

What We Will Do to Correct Problems

Subject to the limitations and exclusions described in this limited warranty, the Manufacturer will remedy defects in materials or workmanship by providing one of the following remedies at its option and without charge to the original purchaser for parts or labor: (a) repairing the defective portion of the WEATHER GUARD® Product or (b) replacing the entire WEATHER GUARD® Product. In addition, the manufacturer may elect at its option, not to repair or replace the WEATHER GUARD® Product, but rather issue to the original purchaser a refund equal to the purchase price paid for the WEATHER GUARD® Product or a credit to be used toward the purchase of new WEATHER GUARD® Product.
